What is Radon ???

Radon is a naturally-occurring radioactive gas that can enter homes from the ground and build up to dangerous levels which may cause cancer.

You **CAN'T** see it, smell it, or taste it.
But, you **CAN TEST** for it!

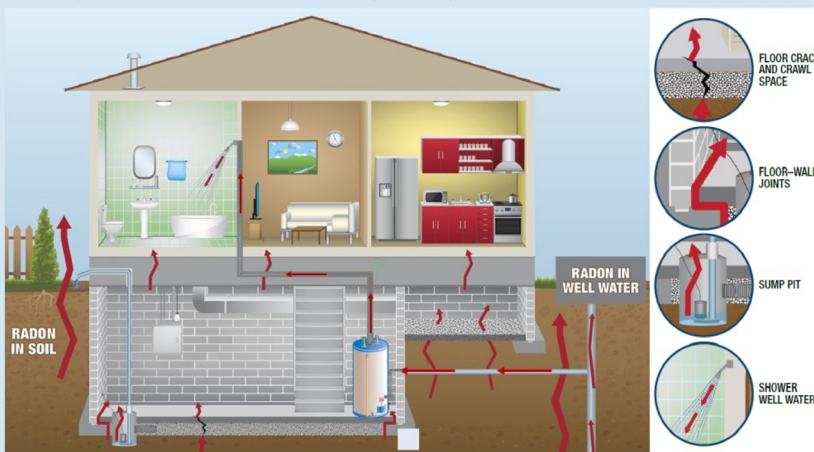
Do you know why it's important to test your home for radon?

- 1 in 15 homes tests high for radon levels**
- Radon is the 2nd leading cause of lung cancer, causing 21,000 lung cancer deaths per year**
- Among non-smokers, radon is the #1 cause of lung cancer**

Radon can enter your home in many ways:

- Cracks in solid floors
- Construction joints
- Cracks in walls
- Gaps in suspended floors
- Gaps around service pipes
- Cavities inside walls
- The water supply
